BACK TO BASICS – WHAT IS ESG INVESTING?

ESG stands for Environmental, Social, and Corporate Governance. ESG criteria help to evaluate a company's impact on its employees, customers, environment, and communities. By assessing ESG scores, it is possible to invest in companies that promote positive changes in society.

Here are the three components of ESG investing (Forbes 2021):

- **Environment:** The impact of a company on the environment is assessed through all of its operations such as the company's carbon footprint, sustainability practices involved in its supply chain, and whether there are toxic chemicals used in its manufacturing process.
- **Social:** Social criteria assess diversity and inclusion such as LGBTQ+ quality and racial diversity in a company's hiring practices and within the executive suite and staff overall. Additionally, it also looks at how much a company supports social initiatives beyond its operations.
- **Governance:** Governance refers to the company's management and advisory board, and how they drive positive change through their interactions with stakeholders, having diversity in leadership positions, and providing fair executive pay.
